# Member's Story



Leesa and Lyric have been a team since Leesa breed her in 2018 from her dog. Since then they have been working towards Working Trials status and recently achieved it. Here is what Leesa has to say about her journey with Lyric.



Lyric started life as a boy, as I was smitten with boy dogs. However, when this little girl showed up, she had me second guessing my initial choice. She changed my mind and I'm so glad she did. Lyric has a "Do stuff, Do anything, Do it now" attitude and it has brought much fun and laughter to my life.

In June 2020 Lyric began competing and attended a Tracking Trials (TT) in Linton and qualified TT1A both days. It was safe to say tracking was in her genes. She attended her first Utility Dog (UD) trial in August, we thought we had trained well, but alas the competition pointed out our areas where we needed some work.

We continued to train and during March and June 2021, we gained our two UDX qualifications. After the June trial I thought that I might be able to teach what was needed for Working Dog (WD) trials and enter her in the Queen's Birthday Trial. First day out to training and she squeezed under the gate and came up lame. Turns out she had partially torn her left hind cruciate. It was instead cage rest, surgery on 3<sup>rd</sup> September, then rehab, and small walks on the lead.

Our future with Working Trials was under a cloud given that we would have to negotiate completing the jumps in WD, which are a pretty big ask for a knee held in place with fishing line! But Lyric recovered fully and gained her two WDX's in April and May of 2022. No more jumping required.

Six beautiful puppies arrived in September 2022 and when they were 9 weeks old we attended her first Tracking Dod (TD) Trial where she qualified with a very respectable TD qualification. Next up was the April TD in Central where she amazingly qualified TDX both days.



After her 2 TDX qualifications all that was needed was her Companion Dog Excellence (CDX) and then she would be awarded the Working Trials Champion title. I got my A into G and entered the CD Trial at Horowhenua on Easter Friday and gained it with ease. Talk about stressful though, I don't think a CD has ever held so much importance to me as that one did!

This journey with Lyric has been interesting, exciting and totally rewarding. She has accomplished so much in a short time given the setbacks of Covid lockdowns, cruciate surgery, and motherhood. I love her spunk, her spirit, her determination, her desire to work, and her true loyalty. Our next goal is to attain 5 more TDX qualifications to get to Working Trials Grand Champion.

# Salmon Fudge



#### **Ingredients:**

- 2 cans of salmon
- 2 eggs
- 1 ½ C quick cook oats
- 1 piece fresh ginger

#### **Process:**

- 1. Preheat oven to 180 degrees Celsius.
- 2. Put salmon, eggs, and ½ cup of oats into a bowl.
- **3.** Grind remaining oats into flour.
- 4. Grate ginger.
- **5.** Mash all together.
- 6. Cover a baking tray with baking paper and use your hands to flatten mix to approximately 6mm thick.
- 7. Bake for 30 mins
- 8. Cut into strips or pieces
- 9. Store in a container in the fridge



# Have a go!



Here is an idea for a game you can play with your dog.

### You'll need:

- Muffin tray
- Tennis balls (or other)
- Treats (any kind that can fit in a muffin tray)
- Step 1 Put some treats into the muffin tray
- Step 2 Place tennis balls in the hole covering the treat
- Step 3 Place in on the ground and watch them figure out how to get the treat out
- Step 4 Once they have the idea, you can fill only a few of the holes so they have to use their nose to figure out which has the treats.

This will mentally tire them out as they will be required to use their nose and also problem solve.
