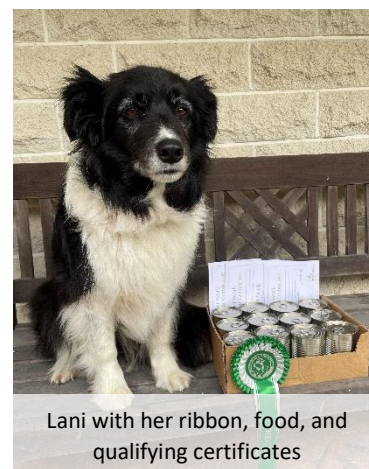

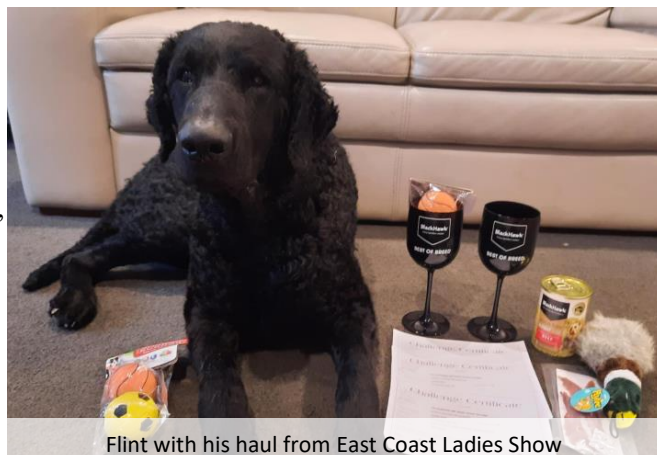

Member's Story



On the 21st September, Tanya and Drive got their final Challenge and have now reach Obedience champion status. This takes hard work, dedication, and team work. Here is what Tanya has to say about the journey:



In 2020, after my child left home, I began searching for a puppy to reignite my passion for competitive Obedience, a sport I had stepped away from for some time. In May, friends told me about a little farm dog puppy that had been rescued, and within days I was on the road, driving to Tauranga and then Auckland to begin a new training journey.

I named him Drive, a nod to that long road trip, and even more so to his incredible food and play drive, which was evident from day one. His natural enthusiasm made training a joy, with Drive always eager to engage, play, and learn.

Just over a year later, we were in the ring, steadily progressing through the grades. By the time Drive turned three, we had qualified to compete in Test C. Our first Test C round without the 'training wheels' was a milestone; we earned our first Challenge Certificate with a second-place finish at NDTA 2023.

There were a few more 'bridesmaid' moments, close calls and near wins, along with some classic blond handler errors that knocked us off course. But thanks to the unwavering support and encouragement from my friends and the Dog Training community, we kept going. Every day, I still took home the best dog in my eyes. Finally, as a true team, we achieved the long-awaited First Place Challenge, earning the prestigious title of Obedience Champion.

Coming back to Obedience felt like I'd never left. I reconnected with old friends and have since made many more. I'd also like to acknowledge the incredible volunteers — judges, stewards, show organisers, and trainers — who make our sport possible. Without you, we wouldn't have the opportunities to compete, grow, and celebrate these achievements.

I'm deeply grateful to the talented handlers and trainers who generously share their knowledge to support and grow our sport. It's not always easy, but every moment of effort is worth it when you achieve the title of Obedience Champion.

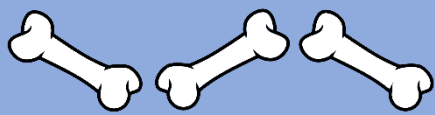

Treat Recipe



DOG ICE CREAM



Ingredients:

- 2 Ripe Bananas
- 1 cup Plain Greek Yoghurt
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup Peanut Butter (*xylitol free*)
- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup Water

Process:

1. In a blender/food processor, combine bananas, Greek yoghurt, peanut butter, and water.
2. Blend until smooth and creamy
3. Pour mixture into ice cube trays or silicone moulds
4. Freeze for at least 2 hours or until solid
5. Pop out the ice cream cubes and serve to your dog as a treat

Tornado, Thunder, Typhoon

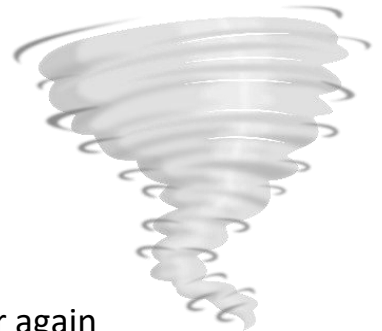
This game is called **Tornado**

Step 1 Grab some of your dog's favourite food

Step 2 Throw a treat out in front of you

Step 3 After your dog eats it and comes back, lead your dog around your body with a treat.

Step 4 Throw the treat out to start the game all over again



You can then add on different variations:

Thunder is a variation when you throw the food in front, then throw the next piece between your legs for your dog to chase. They will go through your legs to get the treat. When they come back through your legs, throw another in front for them to chase.

Typhoon is the most difficult variation. Throw the food in front then as you dog comes back, guide them around one of your legs, then throw a treat for them to go and get. This is a mixture of the two. They are going around one leg instead of the whole body, but they are still going through the middle.
